ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 21, 2012, R.H. Development, LLC (R.H.) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), alleging that the Commission had allowed CEI to "offer a reduced rate for electric heat," and that, consequently, a building owned by R.H. "was wired with two meters." R.H. explained that one of the meters is for heating and air conditioning, while the other meter is for any other electric usage. RH contended that in unoccupied parts of its building "the heat/ac is rarely turned on," yet CEI still collects a minimum service charge for each meter, in addition to a monthly meter charge. R.H. requested that it not be charged "for the second meter, since it was only installed that way for their purposes."
- (2) On July 2, 2012, CEI filed its answer to the complaint. CEI stated that, through various Commission orders, its "discounts for electric heating for certain customers were phased out, while other discounts for electric heating were grandfathered or maintained." CEI added that the R.H. account did not fall into the class of customers for which discounts for electric hearing were grandfathered or maintained. CEI admitted that there are two meters servicing the R.H. account but denied any other allegations and statements made by R.H.




- (3) On July 12, 2012, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling an August 7, 2012, settlement conference. The parties met as scheduled but were unable to resolve matters.
- (4) On August 23, 2012, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling a November 8, 2012, hearing.
- (5) R.H. filed a letter on October 17, 2012, stating its preference to withdraw the complaint.
- (6) The Commission finds that R.H.'s request to withdraw the complaint is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request of R.H. Development, LLC, to withdraw its complaint be granted, and this case be closed. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
