THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE: Thank you.

Is there any counsel representing the Power Siting Board here?

Seeing no one, there are no other intervenors in this case, so I will say that ATSI, American Transmission System, Incorporated, filed this application on August 3, 2012. The subject of today's hearing is an application that was filed by ATSI, a subsidiary of FirstEnergy, proposing to upgrade the Knox substation to improve the quality of electric service and reliability in eastern Ohio.

The project is designed to help

FirstEnergy maintain an adequate level of

transmission reliability and reinforce the 138

kilovolt transmission system in the Canton area.

ATSI plans to convert the existing Knox distribution substation to a transmission switching substation.

The scope of this project includes expanding the fence line of the current substation and constructing a half acre stormwater retention basin on the property. ATSI's plan is to expand the existing facility by approximately 2.1 acres on a 22-acre parcel currently owned by FirstEnergy. ATSI anticipates an in-service date of the summer 2013.

The purpose of this evening's public hearing is to receive comments from the public regarding ATSI's application in this case. It is not a question and answer session, but it is your opportunity to let the Ohio Power Siting Board know what you think about the proposal.

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There is also an evidentiary hearing scheduled to be held in this case which is currently scheduled for November 16, 2012, and that evidentiary hearing will be at the Board's offices in Columbus, Ohio.

I would also note that the Board Staff
Report of Investigation was filed in the docket on
October 22, 2012. This is a recommendation of the
Board Staff and does not necessarily reflect what the
Board's final determination would be.

The Board appreciates your participation in tonight's hearing, and we want everyone to have an opportunity to testify who would like to. I do not have anyone signed up on the sign-in sheet to testify, but I understand there is one gentleman in the audience who would like to testify.
