

Re: Notification of a *Pro Forma* Change in Ownership of T-Mobile Central LLC and Voice Stream Pittsburgh Limited Partnership d/b/a T-Mobile

Dear Ms. McNeal:

T-Mobile Central LLC and Voice Stream Pittsburgh Limited Partnership d/b/a T-Mobile (together, "T-Mobile Ohio"), commercial mobile radio service providers and wholly-owned subsidiaries of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile USA"), hereby notify the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO") of certain proposed transactions that, once consummated, will result in a *pro forma* change in ownership of T-Mobile Ohio. T-Mobile Ohio's ultimate controlling parent, Deutsche Telekom AG ("DT"), and MetroPCS Communications, Inc. ("MetroPCS") have entered into a Business Combination Agreement, dated October 3, 2012 (the "Agreement"), that provides for the combination of T-Mobile USA and MetroPCS that will enable the combined company to create a leading value wireless carrier that is able to more effectively meet the competitive challenges of today's wireless marketplace. Because MetroPCS does not hold spectrum to provide services in or operate in Ohio, the combination of T-Mobile USA and MetroPCS will not reduce the number of wireless service providers operating in the state and, in fact, is expected to strengthen the combined company's ability to compete against larger wireless carriers in the State of Ohio to the benefit of Ohio consumers.

MetroPCS is a facilities-based wireless broadband mobile communications provider offering wireless broadband mobile services in certain metropolitan areas in the United States on no annual contract, unlimited, paid in advance basis. MetroPCS does not operate in Ohio.

The proposed transaction will result in a *pro forma* change in T-Mobile Ohio's intermediate holding company structure, which arguably triggers a notification requirement under Rule 4901: 1-6-24 of the Ohio Administrative Code. As discussed below, the proposed internal restructuring at the intermediate holding company level will not result in any change to T-Mobile Ohio or its parent company, T-Mobile USA, or in a transfer of control of T-Mobile Ohio as the ultimate parent of the company, DT, will remain the same after the consummation of the proposed transaction. Moreover, the *pro forma* changes will not affect T-Mobile Ohio itself or its operations in Ohio.⁴

I. DESCRIPTION OF T-MOBILE USA

Both T-Mobile Central LLC and Voice Stream Pittsburgh Limited Partnership d/b/a T-Mobile are facilities-based commercial mobile radio service providers that are registered as Wireless Service Providers in the State of Ohio. On June 13, 2012, in Case Nos. 12-1175-TP-UNC and 12-1176-TP-UNC, the PUCO granted conditional designation as Eligible Telecommunications Carriers ("ETCs") to both entities for the limited purpose of providing Lifeline service for an interim period of one (1) year, which may be renewed by the PUCO if it finds renewal is appropriate.

T-Mobile Ohio's direct parent, T-Mobile USA, offers national wireless voice, messaging, and data services through its various direct or indirect wholly-owned subsidiaries or limited liability companies. T-Mobile USA's ultimate parent company, DT, is based in Bonn, Germany and is one of the world's leading telecommunications companies with operations in about 50 countries. DT holds all of its interest in T-Mobile USA through its wholly-owned subsidiary T-Mobile Global Zwischenholding GmbH ("T-Mobile Global"), which in turn owns all of the equity and voting interests of T-Mobile Global GmbH ("T-Mobile Holding"), which in turn holds all of the voting and equity interests in T-Mobile Ohio.

III. DESCRIPTION OF THE TRANSACTION

The Agreement between T-Mobile Ohio's ultimate corporate parent, DT, and MetroPCS provides for the combination of T-Mobile USA and MetroPCS into a leading value wireless carrier in the United States which will deliver an enhanced customer experience through broader selection of affordable products and services, more network capacity, and a clear-cut technology path to the common long-term evolution networks. MetroPCS does not hold licenses to provide services in, nor does MetroPCS have facilities or networks in, Ohio. As described below, the proposed transaction also will result in a *pro forma* restructuring of the intermediate holding companies of T-Mobile Ohio.

Under the Agreement, MetroPCS will effect a recapitalization that includes a reverse split of its common stock and a cash payment to its shareholders. Immediately following the reverse stock split and cash payment, T-Mobile Holding will transfer to MetroPCS all of T-Mobile's Holding's ownership interests in T-Mobile USA and MetroPCS will issue to T-Mobile Holding or its designee shares of MetroPCS common stock equal to 74 percent of the fully diluted shares of MetroPCS common stock outstanding at closing. The companies also will consolidate some of the MetroPCS companies in the ownership chain as part of this transaction. As such, the proposed transaction will result in a *pro forma* change in the intermediate holding companies of T-Mobile USA, but not T-Mobile Ohio's immediate parent entity or T-Mobile Ohio. The proposed transaction is *pro forma* because DT will continue to control T-Mobile USA and its subsidiaries (including T-Mobile Ohio) both before and after the transaction. For the Commission's reference, diagrams of the pre- and post-transaction corporate ownership structure of T-Mobile USA are provided as Exhibit A hereto.

T-Mobile USA and MetroPCS have filed applications with the FCC seeking authority to transfer control of the FCC licenses, leases, and authorizations held by MetroPCS and its direct and indirect licensee subsidiaries to DT. T-Mobile USA has also submitted applications to the FCC in connection with the associated *pro forma* change in the intermediate ownership of the FCC licenses, leases and authorizations held by it and its licensee subsidiaries.⁵

IV. PUBLIC INTEREST CONSIDERATIONS

The Agreement and resulting *pro forma* change to T-Mobile Ohio's holding company structure—which is the subject of this notification—will serve the public interest by creating a leading value wireless carrier in the United States that will deliver an enhanced customer experience through a broader selection of affordable products and services, more network capacity and broader network coverage and a clear-cut technology path to one common long-term evolution network. The combined company will have the expanded scale, spectrum and financial resources to aggressively compete with the other larger U.S. wireless carriers. Furthermore, the proposed transaction will not result in any change in ultimate ownership or control of T-Mobile Ohio as DT will continue to be its ultimate controlling parent company. Importantly, the proposed transaction will not affect T-Mobile Ohio itself and will not cause any interruptions or changes to any customer's services in Ohio. Finally, the transaction will not affect the number of competitors in Ohio as MetroPCS does not sell service in Ohio or hold licenses which would permit it to operate facilities in Ohio.




