ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Ohio Power Company (OPCo) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On November 16, 2012, OPCo filed an application for approval of a change in bill format pursuant to Rule 4901:1-10-22(C), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (3) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-10-22(C), O.A.C., if an application for sample bill approval is not acted upon within forty-five calendar days, said sample shall be deemed approved on the forty-sixth day after the filing.
- (4) In order to allow the Commission to fully review the application and to consider the issuance of a Financing Order in Case No. 12-1969-EL-ATS, *In the Matter of the Application of Ohio Power Company for Authority to Impose, Charge and Collect Phase-in Recovery Charges and for Tariff and Bill Format Changes*, which is the case that necessitates the need for this change in bill format, the attorney examiner finds that OPCo's application for approval of a change in bill format should be suspended.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the application for approval of a change in bill format be suspended in accordance with finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
