

SUMMARY OF EDUCATION AND WORK EXPERIENCE OF JESSICA

L.THACKER

1 **Q. HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN EMPLOYED BY FIRSTENERGY SERVICE**
2 **COMPANY, FIRSTENERGY CORP., OR ITS OTHER SUBSIDIARIES OR**
3 **PREDECESSOR COMPANIES?**

4 A. I have been employed with FirstEnergy Service Company continuously since August 4th,
5 2008 for a total of approximately four years.

6
7 **Q. WHAT IS YOUR CURRENT JOB TITLE?**

8 A. I am an Engineer in the Transmission Engineering Group of the Energy Delivery
9 organizational unit.

10
11 **Q. HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN IN YOUR CURRENT POSITION?**

12 A. In October 2011, I was promoted to my current position as Engineer.

13
14 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE YOUR CURRENT POSITION.**

15 A. In this position I provide support for the efforts of FirstEnergy and its subsidiaries, including
16 ATSI, to site new transmission facilities, by assisting with efforts in developing transmission
17 line route siting studies, transmission substation siting studies, and associated regulatory
18 filings. This also involves working with internal and external resources that include
19 FirstEnergy's Legal-Regulatory, Real Estate, Transmission Engineering, Customer Support,
20 External Affairs Managers, Environmental Permitting & Compliance, Vegetation
21 Management, Operations Support, Transmission Lines Services Department, Public
22 Communications, Regional Organizations, Area Managers, and Asset Management
23 Departments.

2 **Q. PLEASE DESCRIBE, BRIEFLY AND GENERALLY, THE POSITIONS YOU HAVE**
3 **HELD IN YOUR CAREER WITH FIRSTENERGY.**

4 A. I was hired by FirstEnergy Service Company in August 2008. The general sequence and
5 time frame of my positions with FirstEnergy are as follows: From August 2008 to June
6 2010, I was part of the rotational program for entry-level engineers as an Assistant Engineer.
7 The program included working in four different departments: the Emergency Operations
8 Center, Transmission Maintenance, the Engineering Department of The Cleveland Electric
9 Illuminating Company (a FirstEnergy subsidiary), and Transmission Siting. My assignments
10 included understanding the function and operation of each group and assisting in the current
11 work activities. In June 2010, I completed the program and was placed in the Transmission
12 Siting Group as an Associate Engineer and then as an Engineer. My current assignments
13 include leading and assisting in the coordination of environmental studies and regulatory
14 permitting for FirstEnergy's transmission projects.

15
16 **Q. STARTING WITH AFTER HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION, PLEASE TELL US**
17 **YOUR EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND.**

18 A. I earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from University of Akron in May
19 2008. In January 2009, I began graduate coursework at the University of Akron for a Master
20 of Business Administration in Management.

21
22 **Q. DO YOU HAVE ANY PROFESSIONAL LICENSES OR CERTIFICATIONS?**

23 A. Yes, I am an Engineer-in-Training in the State of Ohio.

2 **Q. HAVE YOU EVER HAD TO TESTIFY PREVIOUSLY IN OHIO POWER SITING**
3 **BOARD OR OTHER ELECTRIC-UTILITY PROCEEDINGS?**

4 A. Yes. I testified for the Black River Substation Project (Case No. 11-5855-EL-BSB) and the
5 Black River Transmission Line Project (Case No. 11-5856-EL-BTX).
6

7 **Q. HAVE YOU BEEN INVOLVED ON OTHER PROJECTS REQUIRING SUBMITTAL**
8 **OF OTHER TYPES OF SITING FILINGS FOR APPROVAL OF THE**
9 **CONSTRUCTION OF OTHER ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION PROJECTS?**

10 A. Yes, I have either prepared or participated in the preparation of two Application filings,
11 approximately four Construction Notice filings with the Ohio Power Siting Board,
12 approximately six Letter of Notification filings with the Ohio Power Siting Board, and
13 approximately two Letter of Notification in lieu of Application filings with the Pennsylvania
14 Public Utility Commission.
15

16 **Q. WHAT IS YOUR ROLE ON THE PROJECT?**

17 A. I am the person with responsibility for coordinating the Applicants' efforts to obtain the
18 OPSB's authorization to construct the proposed Project. As such, I am responsible for the
19 overall Project, including the Route Selection Study, the preparation of the Application,
20 filing the Application with the OPSB and acting as the Applicants' lead representative to the
21 OPSB Staff throughout the Board's regulatory process.
22

23 **Q. GO ON.**

1 A. In this role, I worked with the subject matter experts with expertise on the various topics that
2 are described in Chapter 4906-15 of the Board's regulations. The subject matter experts
3 were drawn from qualified employees of the Applicants or the Applicants' affiliates or, in
4 some cases, from qualified external consulting firms.

5
6 **Q. DO YOU HOLD FINAL DECISION-MAKING AUTHORITY FOR THE PROJECT?**

7 A. No. The Applicants' executives hold final decision-making authority for the Project. My
8 role is to formulate issues and recommendations for executive review and approval, and to
9 implement the executives' decisions and guidance. As such, I hold responsibility for
10 identifying issues that require executive authorization, presentation of such issues to the
11 executives – including answering questions from the executives, and then executing on
12 executive decisions and direction. In this role, I was the project lead for preparation of the
13 Application draft that was presented for executive authorization. Once the executives
14 approved filing of the Application, I was responsible for acting as the Applicants' lead
15 representative to the OPSB Staff throughout the OPSB's regulatory process.

16
17 **Q. PLEASE IDENTIFY THE RESOURCES THAT WERE AND ARE AVAILABLE TO**
18 **YOU AS YOU PERFORM YOUR DUTIES IN THIS MATTER.**

19 A. I received and continue to receive assistance from the subject matter experts. In addition, I
20 obtained and continue to obtain assistance on an "as needed" basis from other internal
21 FirstEnergy (and affiliated company) personnel in engineering, real estate, regulatory, asset
22 management, legal, construction, forestry, procurement, customer relations, area and
23 community relations, and communications resources. Finally, acting pursuant to executive

1 direction, I have access to, and on an “as needed” basis, receive assistance from external
2 resources, such as URS.
