ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 15, 2012, Buryl Ray Allison (complainant) filed a complaint against American Electric Power Company (AEP). In his complaint, Mr. Allison alleges that AEP trespassed and, without prior notice, unnecessarily cut down trees located on his property.
- (2) On June 4, 2012, AEP filed an answer and a motion to dismiss the complaint.
- (3) By entry issued on July 2, 2012, the attorney scheduled a settlement conference to occur on July 31, 2012.
- (4) After participating in a settlement conference, the complainant filed a motion to dismiss on October 29, 2012. The motion to dismiss explains that the parties have reached a settlement and that the complainant, therefore, requests that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (5) The Commission finds that the motion to dismiss is appropriate and should be granted.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That, pursuant to the complainant's motion to dismiss, the complaint shall be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.


