COMMENT DESCRIPTION:

DP&L wants to add a "service stability rider" to our monthly residential electric bill. The Dayton Daily News reports this would be a \$5.00 monthly charge for the typical household. For our household this would represent a 26% increase to what we now pay for a typical month's electricity generation charge (our average monthly use = 254kwh x \$.076 per kwh = \$19.30 per month paid to FirstEnergy Solutions). In June/July 2011 when we received two offers from competing energy suppliers I called both DP&L and DPL Energy to ask if they could offer a rate

lower than the 9.8cents per kwh they were charging us. They both said no so we switched to FirstEnergy. Now DP&L wants the PUCO to allow them to sock us for an additional \$60.00 a year because they were not competitive in their pricing. I'm going to be polite at this time and just strongly encourage the PUCO to desist in approving a 26% increase to our household's electric energy generation costs. Deny DP&L's request.
