



I, Scott Humphrys, state the following:


1. I am an employee of FirstEnergy Service Company ("FirstEnergy").
2. My current position with FirstEnergy is in Transmission Siting.
3. I am the individual responsible at FirstEnergy, on behalf of the Applicant, American Transmission Systems, Incorporated ("ATSI"), for the development and submittal of the Application for the Fulton Substation to the Ohio Power Siting Board ("Board") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. As part of these duties, I was responsible for the public notice of the public information meeting required by Admin. Code Rule 4906-5-08(B).
4. In July 2011, ATSI submitted a pre-application notice letter to the Board as required by Admin. Code Rule 4906-5-08(A). Originally, ATSI had planned for, and noticed, a public information meeting on July 12, 2011. Due to a delay in providing the pre-application notice to the Board, however, ATSI cancelled the July 12, 2012 public information meeting and rescheduled it for July 28, 2011.

5. Due to the fact that the public notice of the public information meeting originally scheduled for July 12, 2011 had already been published, ATSI published a retraction of the original notice of the public information meeting on July 11, 2012. A further public notice of the public information meeting that identified the rescheduled date of July 28, 2011 was published on July 19, 2011. True and accurate copies of the proofs of publication of the public notice of the original meeting date of July 12, 2011, the retraction and notice of rescheduling of the public information meeting, and the public notice of the July 28, 2011 public information meeting are attached to this affidavit.

Notice of Public Information Meeting for Proposed Major Utility Facility

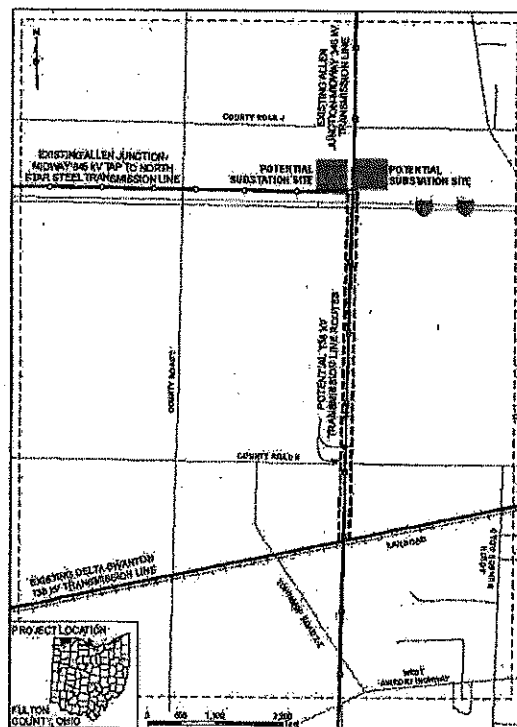
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The proposed Fulton Transmission Substation Project consists of three components:

- 1) installation of a new transmission substation with 345 kV to 138 kV transformation;
- 2) extension of the nearby Allen Junction-Midway 345 kV transmission line to the substation;
- and 3) extension of the Delta-Swanton 138 kV transmission line circuit a short distance to the substation. The project is needed to reinforce the 138 kV transmission lines in the western portion of Toledo Edison's service territory. This reinforcement can be accomplished by installing the proposed substation in the area near where the existing Allen Junction-Midway 345 kV transmission line intersects with the existing Delta-Swanton 138 kV transmission line. The existing 345 kV transmission line is supported on steel lattice towers, and the existing 138 kV transmission line is supported on wood poles. The new section of 345 kV transmission line will be primarily supported on single steel and/or wood pole structures, and the new section of 138 kV transmission line will be primarily supported on single wood poles. Locations for the substation and the associated routes of the transmission line interconnections are currently being evaluated. The general locations of the most favorable sites for the substation and the associated transmission line routes are shown on the map to the right.

Public comments obtained from the meeting will be incorporated into ATSI's process of identifying preferred and alternate sites for the

substation and routes for the 138 kV and 345 kV transmission lines. The Fulton Transmission Substation Project falls under the jurisdiction of the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB). Before construction can begin on the project, ATSI must file an application with the OPSB. The OPSB then must issue a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the project. ATSI plans to make the necessary submittals to the OPSB for the project in September 2011 and if OPSB approval is granted, expects to begin construction on the project in 2012. 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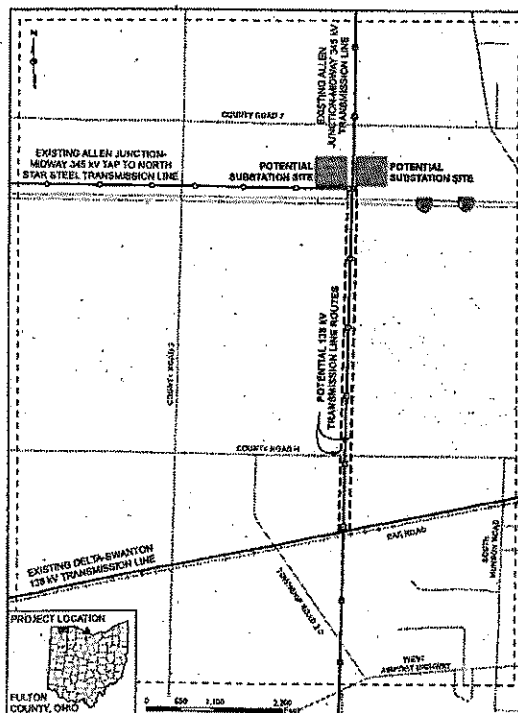

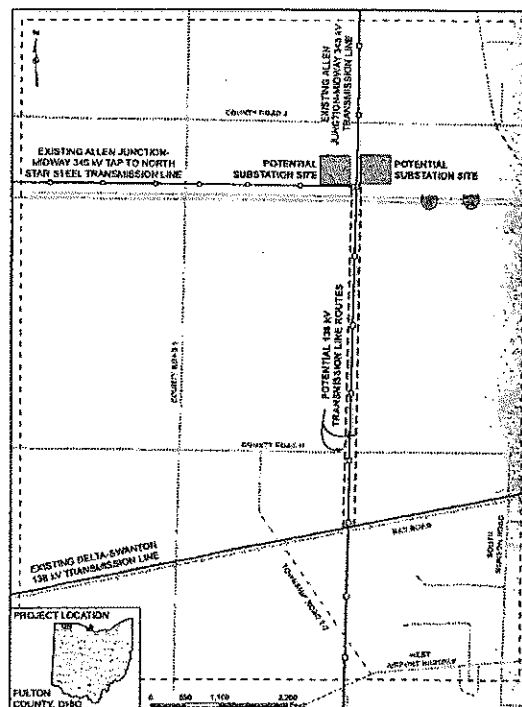

GUATEMALA CITY — Facundo Cabral, 74, the Argentine singer-songwriter shot dead Saturday while on tour in Guatemala, was one of the most eloquent voices of protest against military dictatorships in Latin America from the 1970s onward.

Mr. Cabral was killed when the car in which he was a passenger, on its way to the airport in Guatemala City, was ambushed by unidentified gunmen in three vehicles.

His road manager, David Llanos, and a concert promoter and nightclub owner from Nicaragua, Henry Farina Ponce, were wounded in the attack.

The death of Mr. Cabral, who in 1996 was designated a "worldwide messenger of peace" by the United Nations, caused consternation throughout the Spanish-speaking world.

President Hugo Chavez of Venezuela sent a message via Twitter: "Oh what pain! They have killed the great troubadour of the Pampas."

Rene Perez, leader of the Puerto Rican hip-hop group Calle 13, wrote, "Latin America is in mourning," and other leading pop-music figures, among them Ricky Martin, Alejandro Sanz, and Ricardo Montaner, also sent Twitter messages lamenting his loss.

Guatemalan government officials said Mr. Farina was most likely the gunmen's intended target.

But Rigoberta Menchu, the Guatemalan Indian leader who won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1992, seemed to contradict this view when she said Saturday, "I can't help but think he was assassinated for his ideals."

Rodolfo Enrique Facundo Cabral was born on May 22, 1937, the eighth child of a poor family that soon thereafter emigrated from Buenos Aires province to Tierra del Fuego; it
