## ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- By entry issued October 3, 2012, an evidentiary hearing in this matter was scheduled to occur on December 13, 2012. The entry directed that all discovery requests should be conducted in accordance with Rules 4901-1-16 to 4901-1-24, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) On November 20, 2012, the respondent, AT&T Ohio (AT&T), filed two motions: (a) a motion to compel discovery, filed pursuant to Rule 4901-1-23, O.A.C., and (b) a motion for a continuance of the currently scheduled hearing to a new date which would occur after the complainant has fully responded to the respondent's discovery requests.
- (3) The attorney examiner intends to rule on AT&T's motion to compel discovery in a separate entry to be issued in the near future. In the meantime, it is apparent that the discovery process in this case is not yet complete, nor can it be expected to be completed in time for the December 13, 2012, hearing to proceed as currently scheduled.
- (4) Therefore, the attorney examiner finds that the hearing in this case currently scheduled for December 13, 2012, should be postponed indefinitely, and will be rescheduled, by separate entry, to occur after discovery in this case is completed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the hearing in this matter currently scheduled to occur on December 13, 2012, is postponed indefinitely and will be rescheduled, by separate entry, to occur after discovery in this case is completed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
