- (1)On September 20, 2011, the Commission issued an entry on rehearing in In the Matter of the Annual Alternative Energy Status Report of Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company, Case In that entry on rehearing, the No. 11-2479-EL-ACP. Commission stated that it had opened the above-captioned case for the purpose of reviewing the Rider AER of Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy or the Companies).
