In accordance with Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4901:1-27-10 "Material changes in business", Exelon Energy Company ("Exelon Energy") herein provides notice to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") of a change in Exelon Energy's corporate structure.

On March 22, 2012, the Commission was notified that Exelon Corporation, parent company of Exelon Energy, acquired Constellation Energy Group, Inc. and its subsidiaries, including Constellation NewEnergy, Inc. ("CNE"), Constellation NewEnergy – Gas Division, LLC ("CNEG"), and Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. ("CEGCI"). CNE is a licensed Competitive Retail Electric Supplier (CRES) in Ohio (Certificate No. 00-003E(6)); both CNEG and CEGCI are licensed Competitive Retail Natural Gas Suppliers (CRNGS) in Ohio (Certificate Nos. 09-153G(2) and 02-021G(6), respectively). All Constellation entities are in good standing with the Commission.

On October 1, 2012, as part of the ongoing integration of the company, Exelon Energy merged with and into two of its corporate affiliates. More specifically, Exelon Energy's gas assets and operations merged with and into CNEG with CNEG as the surviving entity. At the same time, Exelon Energy's electric supply assets and operations merged with and into CNE with CNE as the surviving entity. As of October 1, 2012, Exelon Energy Company has ceased to exist. A chart showing the organizational structure after giving effect to the Change in Corporate Structure is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Both CNE and CNEG have assumed all obligations for Exelon Energy's respective electric and natural gas activities in Ohio. However, to provide a more seamless transition for Exelon Energy's natural gas choice customers in Ohio, Exelon Energy assigned its gas choice contracts to CEGCI effective September 30, 2012 on the same terms and conditions as with Exelon

Energy. Exelon Energy, CNE, CNEG and CECGI provided advance notice of these transactions to all of its customers in Ohio via bill insert and direct mail pieces, copies of which are attached as Exhibit B.

The officer and director slate, management team and financial qualifications for CNE, CECGI and CNEG remain intact as previously submitted to the Commission. Also, all previously appointed points of contact for CNEG, CECGI and CNE will remain. Thus, no updates are required to this information.

In light of these changes and the fact that CNE possesses its own CRES license and both CNEG and CECGI possess their own CRNGS licenses, in the near future we will be submitting a notice of termination of Exelon Energy's CRES and CRNGS licenses.

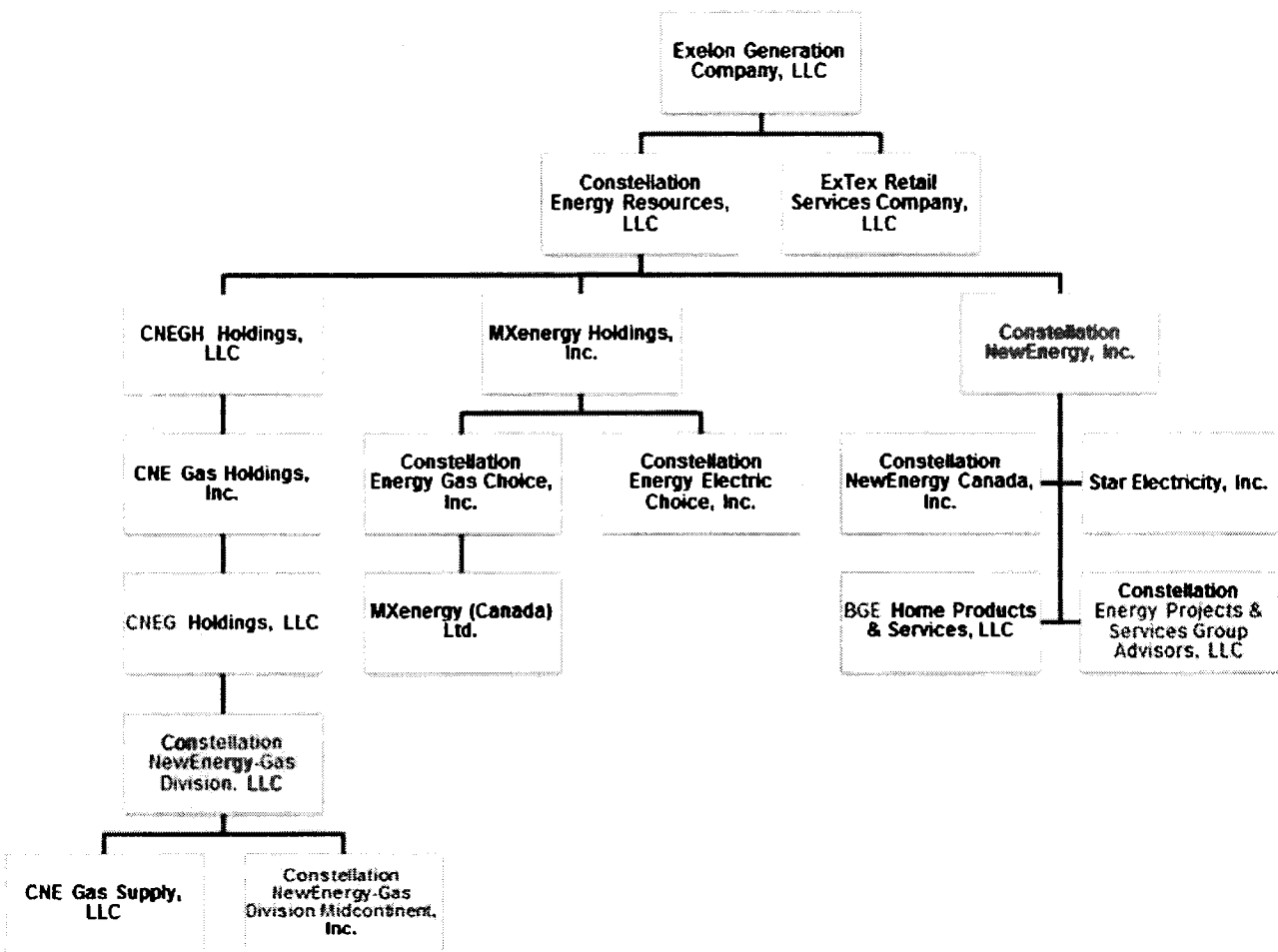

As part of the ongoing integration related to that merger, on October 1, 2012 Exelon Energy Company's ("Exelon Energy") retail natural gas customers will start to be served by Constellation's retail natural gas organization Constellation NewEnergy Gas Division, LLC ("Constellation"). Rest assured that no changes are being made to your contract term and price as a result of this change and you will continue to deal with your current sales representative. On October 1, 2012 your Exelon Energy gas supply contract will become a Constellation contract by operation of law. Constellation hereby confirms its assumption of all obligations of Exelon Energy under your contract, including any active transaction confirmations or pricing exhibits, as of October 1, 2012. Due to this reorganization, there are also some logistical changes that will occur. Before your next contract renewal date your current sales representative will discuss with you the need to execute a new Constellation contract. Constellation's contract structure differs from Exelon Energy's structure. Constellation utilizes a base enabling agreement that contains terms and conditions that govern the purchase and sale of natural gas and related services. Specific transactions are then entered into and documented in "Transaction Confirmations" that attach to and are subject to the base agreement. This means that each transaction will not need a new base agreement, only a new Transaction Confirmation, which contains the details of the particular deal.

Should you desire to enter into a new transaction with Constellation at any point after October 1, 2012, Constellation's standard transaction procedures will be used. Like most gas suppliers, Constellation enters into transactions with customers via electronic transmission, written record or orally and each party is bound by the terms of a transaction at the time the parties agree to the terms. It is then Constellation's standard practice to send the customer a Transaction Confirmation containing the details of the transaction. The customer then has two (2) business days to notify Constellation if anything contained in the Transaction Confirmation is incorrect. If the customer does not object to any terms, the Transaction Confirmation shall constitute the definitive written expression of the transaction.

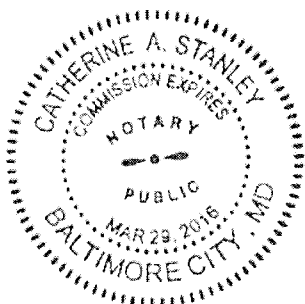
