## COMPLAINT DESCRIPTION:

My electric usage in December of 2011 was 2084 KWH, and my bill was \$149.32. My electric usage in December of 2012 was 1784 KWH and my bill was \$192.43, due to a huge increase in the distribution rate awarded to AEP by the PUCO, and additional costs(retail stability rider).
