EXAMINER TAUBER: Let's go on the record. The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has called for hearing at this time and place Case No. 12-3007-RR-RCP being in the Matter of a Request for an Exemption by the Wellston City School District at the Pennsylvania Avenue Grade Crossing, which is No. 151440G, located in Wellston, Ohio.

My name is Jon Tauber. I am the Attorney Examiner assigned by the Commission to preside over this afternoon's hearing. The purpose of this afternoon's hearing will be to take public comment regarding the exemption request.

Once public comment is taken it will become a part of the official record. You may 12 proceed with your statement. 13 14 KAREN BOCH 15 being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was 16 examined and testified as follows: 17 DIRECT EXAMINATION 18 THE WITNESS: Basically the reason we 19 asked for this railroad crossing to be exempt is 20 because it is directly, I don't know, diagonal from 2.1 our -- our bus garage, and when the buses have to 22 turn right, they immediately turn right and have to 23 stop, and so it could cause an accident. 24 The other reason is that this railroad 25 crossing is totally dysfunctional so there are no

THE WITNESS: I have been here six years, and it has been inactive. I have lived in Wellston for 25, and I would say most of that time.

EXAMINER TAUBER: Thank you. Do you have anything you wish to add?

THE WITNESS: That's all. Thank you.

EXAMINER TAUBER: Thank you.
