
Dear Ms.McCauly:

I am writing on behalf of the Village of Wilkesville, Vinton County, Ohio. This letter is in reference to a letter from Sally W. Bloomfield of Bricker and Bricker LLP. I have enclosed a copy of the letter. The village objects to her calling the baseball field "abandoned". The ball field is used by some religious organizations in the summer. True, no little league teams use it on a regular basis, but the ball field is still used and is not abandoned. The village would like to have the word abandoned stricken from this document.

Secondly, some of the council members wonder why Rolling Hills is going to lay two pipe lines to the Ohio River, pump water to and from the Ohio River when the abandoned Meigs mine complex pumps out one million gallons of water per day. The mine complex is located approximately seven miles from Rolling Hills. Rolling Hills could also drill water wells and create a small lake to recirculate the water. This would seem to be more cost effective and keep consumers bills smaller.
