Man faces charges in Minerva school threat

— many due to wintertime illness and others out of fear.
Police Chief Robert First

ronce Chief Robert First said a man who had been told to stay away from the school returned Monday, alarming students and school personnel. First said the man uttered the words, "No more high school.' Students who overheard were railled and spread word oo Facebook and other social media. "With that statement, he caused a lot of panic," the chief said.

Kevin Wingert, 51, of Stafford Street, was arrested and booked into the Stark County Jail just befure 11 am. Tuesday, on a felony charge of inducing panica and a mischemeanor charge of treppassing, jail records said. Superintendent Joseph Chaddock said that Wingert had previously been asked not to come on school property. He declined to provide details. Chaddock said police and school officials worked through the night Monday and Tuesday morning to ensure students were safe.

At 10 a.m. Tuesday, Chaddock said 10 to 15 percent and staff members notifying them that the situation had been dealt with and that the man was behind bars. Chaddock said 10 to 15 percent wer likely out due to Uliness, as has been the recent norm. Those who stayed home due to the situation irvoking Wingert likely numbered 5 to 10 percent, he said.

Wingert remained in the Stark County Jail later Tuesday, held in lieu of \$50,250 bond, jail records said.

AEP Ohio and AEP Ohio Transmission Company (AEP Ohio Transco) propose to improve the transmission system in Stark County by installing a second circuit along its existing Wagentesis-West Canton 138-kilovolt (kV) line

The purpose of the project is to install a second circuit on the vacant position along the existing tower line. Construction is scheduled to begin in March 2013.

The project is known as the Wagenhals-West Carrion 138-kV Line Improvement Project. As required by Dhio Revised Code Section 4906-1101. APP Ohio Transco has filed a Larter of Notification with the state of Chio Power String Board.


This project qualifies as a Letter of Notification filing because it meets the requirements orn-lined in OAC 4906-1-01, Item (4(a) of the Inter-im Application Requirement Matrix for Electric Power Transmission Lines in Aggendix A.

The Letter of Notification for the Wagenhets-West Centon 138-kV Line Improvement Project is pending before the Othe Power String Board. This application has been assigned Case Number 13-170-EL-BLN. This number should be included in ell communications with respect to this proceeding.

Potitions to intervene in or comment on the Let-ter of Notification will be excepted by the string board up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice required by Public 4905 5-08(CRI), DAP, Petritions should be addressed to Ohio Power String Board, 108 East Broad Street, Columbus, Chini, 43215-3793 and must cire the above-1sted care number

The Wagenhals-West Canton 138-kV transmission line involves installing a second conductor circuit on an esting tower line that has a vecent position for approximately 10 miles and replacing eight lettice towers with single pole devit arm structures. Because the now conductor will be installed on the vacant side, the project will be located on the existing right of way of the Wagenhals-West Conton 138-kV Line Project.

The substation expansion will be an approximate \$2 million investment by AEP in its transmission system in the area. The project will allow AEP to continue to provide the level of service its customers expect.



The accompanying map depicts the expansion site.
