ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 20, 2012, the Commission Staff (Staff) opened this docket for the 2011 annual review of the Companies' Advanced Metering Infrastructure/Modern Grid Rider (Rider AMI). On February 15, 2012, Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy or the Companies) filed a report in support of the 2011 review of Rider AMI.
- (2) On February 27, 2012, Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed a motion to intervene in this proceeding. No party filed a memorandum contra OCC's motion to intervene. The attorney examiner finds that OCC's motion to intervene is reasonable and should be granted.
- (3) On February 19, 2013, Staff filed comments on the Companies' report concerning the annual review of Rider AMI.
- (4) In order to accomplish the 2011 annual review of Rider AMI, the attorney examiner finds that the following procedural schedule should be established:
  - (a) The deadline for the filing of comments shall be April 5, 2013.
  - (b) The deadline for the filing of reply comments shall be April 22, 2013.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That OCC's motion to intervene be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the procedural schedule set forth in finding (4) be adopted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
