ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 12, 2012, the Commission issued an entry initiating an investigation into Ohio's retail electric service market, which established deadlines for interested parties to file comments and reply comments of January 30, 2013, and February 15, 2013, respectively.
- (2) Thereafter, by entry issued January 24, 2013, the deadlines for interested parties to file comments and reply comments were extended to March 1, 2013, and March 29, 2013, respectively.
- (3) On March 22, 2013, the Retail Energy Supply Association (RESA), filed a motion for a one-week extension of the deadline to file reply comments until April 5, 2013. In its memorandum in support, RESA lists multiple reasons for its request, including religious holidays occurring the week of March 25, an annual meeting for energy consultants involving several RESA members, multiple hearings ongoing at the Commission, as well as the complexity and scope of the issues addressed in the initial comments. Finally, RESA represents in its motion that it contacted several of the parties who filed initial comments in the case, that no party contacted objected to the requested extension, and that several parties support the requested extension.
- (4) The attorney examiner finds that RESA's motion for a oneweek extension of the deadline for interested parties to file reply comments is reasonable and should be granted. Consequently, reply comments shall be due by April 5, 2013.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That parties wishing to address the questions set forth in the December 12, 2012, Commission Entry, file reply comments by April 5, 2013. It is, further,

ORDERED, That notice of this entry be served upon all electric utilities, all certified competitive retail electric service providers, all governmental aggregators providing retail electric service, all other interested parties via the Commission's electric-energy list serve, and all parties of record.
