

The purpose of this tariff filing is to make revisions in order to appropriately mirror Interstate Access rates as required by the FCC's Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in WC Docket No. 07-135 et al., In the Matter of Establishing Just and Reasonable Rates for Local Exchange Carriers.
