

# Letter of Notification for PIR-521 – Southway Street West High Pressure Distribution Pipeline Replacement (L#1152)

Ohio Power Siting Board Case No. 13-1108-GA-BLN

Submitted by Dominion East Ohio Gas Company – May 2, 2013

The following information is being provided in accordance with the procedures delineated in Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Rule 4906-11-01: <u>Letter of Notification Requirements</u> of the Rules and Regulation of the Ohio Power Siting Board.

### 4906-11-01(B) GENERAL INFORMATION

### **4906-11-01(B)(1)(a):** Name and Reference Number

The proposed project is the Dominion East Ohio Gas ("DEO") Line #1157

Natural Gas Pipeline Replacement. The project will be referenced with DEO as PIR 521,

Southway Street West, SAP Notification #P400000890.

# 4906-11-01(B)(1)(b): Brief Description of Project

The PIR 521 – Southway Street West project consists of replacing approximately 9,200 feet of 8-inch, high pressure, bare steel pipeline with 12-inch, high pressure, coated steel pipeline, and 1,397 feet of medium pressure 4-inch bare steel pipeline with medium density plastic pipeline. There will be 16 services affected by replacement of the medium pressure mainline. This project will involve Southway Street SW, from Harcrest Avenue to Genoa Ave, in the City of Massillon and Perry Township, Stark County.

The existing 8-inch, high pressure, bare steel pipeline, L#1157, shall be replaced with a single 12-inch high pressure steel pipeline. The new pipeline will be coated and cathodically protected with anodes. Pipe replacement shall be installed entirely within road right-of-way. The existing distribution pipeline being replaced was installed in 1938 with a MAOP of 160 pounds per square inch – gas (psig).

A project overview map included as Attachment A.

# 4906-11-01(B)(1)(c): Why the Project Meets the Requirements for a Letter of Notification

The new pipeline replacement will be approximately 1.75 miles in length. Thus this project qualifies as a Letter of Notification because it fits the criteria of OAC Rule 4906-1-01, Appendix B(4) because:

- (a) the new line will replace an existing line; and
- (b) the new line will be greater than one mile but not greater than five miles in length

The replaced pipeline would have the equivalent rating and operating characteristics of the existing line.

# 4906-11-01(B)(2): Name and Reference Number

The replacement of the existing 8-inch bare steel, high-pressure, distribution mainline with the proposed 12-inch high pressure coated steel mainline is a pipeline replacement project performed under DEO's Pipeline Infrastructure Replacement (PIR) Program and will be eligible for recovery.

## **4906-11-01(B)(3):** Location of the Project

Attachment A illustrates the location of existing distribution pipeline (L#1157). The new 12-inch replacement pipeline segments shall be installed within Southway Street SW rights-of-way.

4906-11-01(B)(5): Anticipated Construction Schedule and Proposed In-Service

**Date** 

The construction on the project may begin as early as the June 1st and be

completed by September 2, 2013. The new line is expected to be in service no later than

September 16, 2013.

4906-11-01(B)(6): Project Area Map and Directions

Attachment A shows a high-level view of the project and, as defined within the

construction plans (Attachment B), the entire length of the proposed route will be located

within existing road rights-of-way.

Travel to the site from Columbus can be accomplished by taking I-71 North

toward Cleveland (approximately 67 miles). Merge onto US-30 East via Exit 176 toward

Wooster (approximately 51.4 miles). Take the OH-627 / Richville Drive Exit and turn

left onto Richville Drive SW / OH-627. Continue to follow Richville Drive SW

(approximately 1.8 miles). Turn right onto Southway Street (0.04 miles), the intersection

of Southway Street SW and Harcrest Avenue SW is immediate.

**4906-11-01(B)(7):** Property Owner List

DEO will not be required to obtain new land rights for the proposed replacement

project as the installation will be placed within existing road right-of-way and DEO

easements.

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### 4906-11-01(C) TECHNICAL FEATURES OF THE PROJECT

# 4906-11-01(C)(1): Operating Characteristics, Required Structures, and Right-of-Way and/or Land Requirements

**Pipeline MAOP:** The high-pressure pipeline to be replaced operates at an MAOP of 160 psig.

*Pipe Material:* Existing 8-inch bare steel pipeline will be replaced with 12-inch, .375w, X42, Fusion Bond Epoxy coated steel pipe.

Structures: No additional structures will be required for the replaced pipeline.

**Right-of-Way** (**ROW**) and/or Land Requirement: Pipe replacement shall take place within the existing road rights-of-way.

### 4906-11-01(C)(2): Electric and Magnetic Fields

This project involves the replacement of a natural gas pipeline; therefore, this section is not applicable.

## **4906-11-01(C)(3):** Estimated Capital Costs

The capital cost of this project is estimated to be \$2,198,100.

## 4906-11-01(D) SOCIOECONOMIC DATA

### 4906-11-01(D)(1): Land Use

The proposed construction project is located within the City of Massillon (approximately 3,800 feet of pipeline replacement) and Perry Township (5,400 feet of pipeline replacement), Stark County, Ohio. The entire length of the proposed route will be located within road rights-of-way. Land use associated with the project area is primarily residential with some agricultural areas.

Estimated population density for Massillon, Stark County, Ohio is 1,918 per square mile (http://www.city-data.com/city/Massillon-Ohio.html)

Estimated population density for Perry Township, Stark County, Ohio is 1,211 per square mile (http://www.city-data.com/township/Perry-Stark-OH.html)

## 4906-11-01(D)(2): Agricultural Land

There are tracts of farm fields located along the Southside of Southway Street SW, but they are out of the construction disturbance area.

### **4906-11-01(D)(3):** Cultural Resources

Davey Resources conducted a site visit of the project area on October 21, 2011 and November 10, 2011. The PIR 521 project is situated within residential, commercial, and agricultural areas with land cover of mowed grass, lawn trees, pavement, successional woods, pasture, and fallow farm fields.

To evaluate this site for potential cultural resources, the project area was reviewed for physical features that may indicate historic structures. No rock outcrops, rock overhangs, historic foundations, or other features were observed within the project area that would indicate significant historic or prehistoric cultural use of the area. See the last page of the letter of Attachment J-1. An update to the report was not available at the time of filing. It will be filed shortly.

## **Section 106 Desktop Review**

In order to determine if documented historic sites exist within and adjacent to the project area, a Section 106 Desktop Review was performed (see Attachment C). No listed or inventoried properties, districts, or survey areas records were identified within

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or adjacent to the pipeline right-of-way by the search of the OHPO data records. Refer to the OHPO maps in Attachment C.

### **Summary**

Because of previous ground disturbance, OHPO does not require a formal Section 106 consultation for pipeline replacement projects unless historic properties will be impacted by the project. The degree of disturbance and the absence of identified cultural resources within or adjacent to the project area indicate that this project does not have the potential to contain intact archaeological resources eligible for listing in the *National Register of Historic Places*. Therefore, the installation of pipeline for PIR 521 – Southway Street SW will not have an adverse effect on cultural resources.

### **Public Information Program**

In accordance with the Second Finding and Order dated December 17, 2012 in Case No. 12-1981-GE-BRO, Finding No. 5(c), DEO will publish notification of project in the Canton Repository within seven days of the filing of this Letter of Notification. A copy of the Public Notice is attached as Attachment E.

On July 12, 2012, DEO notified residents, listed on Attachment F, of a natural gas mainline replacement study (Attachment G, first letter).

After the project is awarded to a construction contractor and a construction schedule is established, another letter will be sent to residents advising of the proposed schedule. (Attachment G, second model letter).

# 4906-11-01(D)(4)(b): Public Information Program

Given this is a replacement of existing facility, no public information program, materials, or meetings were conducted for the siting of this proposed facility.

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LINE REPLACEMENT (L#1152)

4906-11-01(D)(5): Current and Pending Litigation

There is no current or pending litigation involving the replacement of the existing

line.

4906-11-01(D)(6): Local, State and Federal Permits and Requirements

Plans were submitted to Stark County and the City of Massillon for construction

permitting (Attachment H). There is no other known local, state, or, federal requirement

that must be met prior to commencement of construction on the proposed pipeline

replacement project.

A construction storm water pollution prevention plan ("SWPPP") has been

prepared for the project (Attachment I-1). The SWPPP will be included in the package

submitted for competitive bids from contractors.

DEO has submitted a Notice of Intent for Coverage Under the Construction Storm

Water General Permit to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and copied the Stark

County Soil and Water Conservation District (Attachment I-2).

DEO has submitted a Pre-Construction Notification with the Department of the

Army, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers requesting coverage under Nationwide Permit 12

(Attachment I-3).

4906-11-01(E) ENVIRONMENTAL DATA

**4906-11-01(E)(1):** Species of Concern

DEO's consultant, Davey Resources, performed a site visit in the proposed

project area on October 21, 2011 and November 10, 2011. Based upon the consultant's

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finding that no listed species or critical habitats were identified in the project area and a determination of "no effect" on listed species, their habitats, or proposed designated critical habitat, DEO has requested concurrence from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service that the proposed DEO Pipeline Replacement Project is not likely to adversely affect any federally listed threatened or endangered species in the project area (Attachment J-1).

DEO has also requested a finding from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources regarding any adverse effect to any state-listed species (Attachment J-2).

### 4906-11-01(E)(2): Areas of Ecological Concern

The consultant, Davey Resources, likewise made an ecological assessment during the site visit in October and November 2011 to evaluate the project area for the presence of streams, wetlands and any other sensitive resources. The consultant concluded that there are four (4) wetlands and three (3) streams in the project area, noting that the project area is largely a residential area with some agricultural areas.

To install the pipeline for this project, it is necessary to temporarily impact Streams 2 and 3 and Wetland D. Following installation of the pipeline, the disturbed areas will be restored to pre-existing grade and the stream banks will be stabilized and revegetated. All Best Management Practices will be utilized to minimize sedimentation and erosion. No permanent impacts to these water resources will occur with the installation of pipeline for this project.

The letter to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources regarding any adverse effect to natural areas with ecological and/or geological significance based on Davey Resources studies is included as Attachment J-2.

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
# 4906-11-01(E)(3): Any Known Unusual Conditions Resulting in Significant Environmental, Social, Health, or Safety Impacts

DEO's consultant, Davey Resources, confirmed that there are no known unusual conditions resulting in significant environmental impacts (see Attachment J-1). Because this project is located in an area where there are other infrastructure facilities similar to the proposed new line, other than potential health and safety issues associated with construction which will be minimized with the best practices during construction, there are no additional health, social or safety impacts that will exist as a result of this project.

FOR ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING THIS REQUIREMENT, PLEASE CONTACT DEO'S MANAGER OF CONTRACT SERVICES OR DEO'S ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT GROUP. SAW CUT SLURRY RUNOFF TO BE CONTAINED PER SWPPP REQUIREMENTS.



TYPE 6 CURB W/UNDERDRAIN DETAIL




