The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 14, 2012, American Broadband and Telecommunications Company (American Broadband or complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T or respondent) concerning a billing dispute.
- (2) Pursuant to joint motions filed on July 10, 2012, September 10, 2012, November 15, 2012, and January 14, 2013, the attorney examiner stayed this proceeding for successive 60-day periods to allow the parties to continue negotiations toward resolving the dispute.
- (3) On May 1, 2013, American Broadband filed a motion to extend the stay for an additional 60 days. American Broadband states that the parties have continued to discuss issues raised by the complaint but have not reached a mutually acceptable resolution. American Broadband moves for an additional 60day stay to allow negotiations to continue. AT&T did not file a memorandum contra.
- (4) American Broadband has stated good cause to continue the stay. Accordingly, the attorney examiner shall grant the motion and continue the stay for an additional 60 days, until July 12, 2013.
