## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1)On May 21, 2013, Scott Warner, District 11 Railroad Coordinator of the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), filed a letter, pursuant to Section 4511.63, Revised Code, requesting an exemption for school buses and motor vehicles carrying certain hazardous materials from stopping at grade crossing AARDOT No. 503327N, located on State Route 7 (Grant Avenue) in Martins Ferry, Belmont County, Ohio. According to Mr. Warner, at that location State Route 7 is a four lane highway with a speed limit of 50 miles per hour. He asserts that approval of the exemption would increase safety for school buses and certain hazardous materials vehicles by eliminating their need to stop on such a highway. Mr. Warner adds that, on a daily basis, there are three switching trains traveling at 5 mph that use this spur line.
- (2) Commission staff should file a report of investigation regarding the request by June 18, 2013.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that, in order for the public to have an opportunity to comment on the exemption request, a local hearing should be scheduled. Accordingly, a public hearing on this matter should be held on Monday, July 15, 2013, at 11:00 a.m. at the Martins Ferry Public Library, 20 S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Martins Ferry, Ohio 43935.

(4) The secretary of the Commission should cause publication of the following legal notice in a newspaper of general circulation in Belmont County, Ohio, one time, not less than seven days prior to the scheduled hearing:

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has scheduled a public hearing in Case No. 13-1226-RR-RCP, on a request for an exemption for school buses and motor vehicles carrying certain hazardous materials from stopping at grade crossing AARDOT No. 503327N, located on State Route 7 (Grant Avenue) in Martins Ferry, Belmont County, Ohio.

The purpose of the hearing will be to take public comment regarding the exemption request. The hearing will be held on July 15, 2013, 11:00 a.m., at the Martins Ferry Public Library, 20 S. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Martins Ferry, Ohio 43935. ORDERED, That the Secretary of the Commission cause publication of the legal notice in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,
