

THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

FINDING AND ORDER

- (1) Waterville Gas & Oil Company (Waterville) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) By order issued on November 20, 2007, in *In the Matter of the Application of Waterville Gas & Oil Company for Authority to Amend its Tariffs to Increase the Rates and Charges for Gas Services and Related Matters*, Case No. 07-194-GA-AIR, the Commission approved a stipulation which, *inter alia*, established an initial uncollectible expense (UEX) rider for Waterville. The UEX rider was initially set at \$0.03 per thousand cubic feet (Mcf).
- (3) Since that time, Waterville has filed updates to adjust the rider rate and the Commission has authorized such revisions. Waterville's current UEX rider is set at \$0.0080 per Mcf.
- (4) On May 13, 2013, as amended on May 23, 2013, Waterville filed its application to revise its current UEX rider rate. As of April 30, 2013, Waterville's over-collection balance was \$2,362.24. Therefore, Waterville proposes to adjust the UEX rider and decrease it by \$0.0123, which results in a rate of (\$0.0043) per Mcf. According to Waterville, based on the estimated sales volumes, the over-collection balance will be eliminated based on the new rate.
- (5) Staff reviewed the application and, on May 29, 2013, filed its comments recommending approval of the proposed rider rate.
- (6) The Commission has reviewed the application, as amended, and the Staff's comments and finds the proposed decrease to

Waterville's UEX rider is reasonable and in the public interest, and should be approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Waterville's application, as amended, be approved, and Waterville be authorized to decrease its UEX rider to (\$0.0043) per Mcf. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Waterville is authorized to file two complete copies of tariffs, in final form, consistent with this Finding and Order. Waterville shall file one copy in this case docket and one copy in its TRF docket (or may file electronically as directed in Case No. 06-900-AU-WVR). It is, further,


ORDERED, That the effective date of the new tariffs shall be a date not earlier than the date upon which final tariffs are filed with the Commission. It is, further,


ORDERED, That nothing in this Finding and Order shall be binding upon this Commission in any future proceeding or investigation involving the justness or reasonableness of any rate, charge, rule, or regulation. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Finding and Order be served upon all parties of record.


