## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On July 18, 2012, the Commission issued an order in In the Matter of Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company for Authority to Provide for a Standard Service Offer Pursuant to Section 4928.143, Revised Code, in the Form of an Electric Security Plan, Case No. 12-1230-EL-SSO. In that order, the Commission found that Ohio Edison Company, The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company, and The Toledo Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy or the Companies) should file annually an application for the review of the Companies' Generation Service Rider (Rider GEN).
- (2) On May 1, 2013, the Companies filed an application for the review of Rider GEN, a request that the Commission approve the Companies' proposed Rider GEN, as well as tariffs to reflect the changes to Rider GEN which automatically took effect June 1, 2013.
- (3) Thereafter, on May 30, 2013, the Commission's Staff (Staff) filed comments on the Companies' application. In its comments, Staff states that it performed an audit of the tariff pages presented by the Companies and finds the submitted tariff pages and tariff rates for Rider GEN to be prudent and reasonable. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the application.
- (4) The Commission finds that Staff's recommendation is reasonable and should be adopted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That FirstEnergy's application for Rider GEN are reasonable and are approved. It is, further,

ORDERED, That FirstEnergy be authorized to file in final form four complete copies of the tariff pages consistent with this entry and to cancel and withdraw its superseded tariff pages. FirstEnergy shall file one copy in its TRF docket (or may make such filing electronically as directed in Case No. 06-900-AU-WVR) and one copy in this docket. The remaining two copies shall be designated for distribution to the Rates and Tariffs Division of the Commission's Utilities Department. FirstEnergy shall also update its tariffs previously filed electronically with the Commission's Docketing Division. It is, further,

ORDERED, That FirstEnergy shall notify all affected customers via bill message or bill insert within 30 days of the effective date of the tariffs. A copy of the customer notice shall be submitted to the Commission's Service Monitoring and Enforcement Department, Reliability and Service Analysis Division, at least 10 days prior to its distribution to customers. It is, further,

ORDERED, That nothing in this entry shall be binding upon this Commission in any future proceeding or investigation involving the justness or reasonableness of any rate, charge, rule, or regulation. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all interested parties.
