## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Pursuant to Section 4905.31, Revised Code, and Rule 4901:1-38-05(B), Ohio Administrative Code, a mercantile customer of an electric utility may apply to the Commission for a unique arrangement with the electric utility.
- (2) On May 10, 2013, Globe Metallurgical, Inc. (Globe) filed an application for approval of an amendment to its unique arrangement with Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio). In its application, Globe proposes to move up the current contract termination date from December 31, 2018, to June 1, 2015, and to incorporate a fixed price as opposed to a percentage off AEP Ohio's tariff rates. The application provides that Globe will remain an interruptible customer for AEP Ohio until the June 2015 billing cycle, or until AEP Ohio procures capacity for its standard service offer by auction, whichever is earlier. Globe adds that the approval of its amendment application will allow Globe to maintain its facilities and allow for the expansion of its workforce by ten percent.
- (3) On May 30, 2013, AEP Ohio filed a motion to intervene. No memoranda contra were filed. The attorney examiner finds that the motion to intervene is reasonable and should be granted.
- (4) The attorney examiner finds that a hearing should be held in order to consider the amendment application. Accordingly, this matter should be set for hearing on August 6, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-D, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
