Gentlemen:

The Ohio State Legislative Board, United Transportation Union, representing Ohio railroad employees wishes to file a weed and vegetation complaint (Ohio Administrative Code 4901-5-22) against CSX Transportation (CSXT), which railroad is subject to regulation under Chapters 4905 and 4907 of the Revised Code.

In conducting its railroad operation in the vicinity of Columbus, Ohio, said company has permitted unsafe and hazardous conditions to arise due to the excessive growth of weeds and vegetation on its C&N Subdivision on the Louisville Division between Mileposts BP 130 and BP 133, at the following locations:

1. Thick weeds and brush are creating hazardous conditions on both sides of the track from the switch leading into Warehouse Service, off the West Port Siding at Milepost 133.7, to the first switch in the industry. Warehouse Service, 600 North Cassady Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43219.

Directions: This industry can be reached by taking the East 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue exit from I-670 and heading east. Turn right on Cassady Avenue and the industry is a short distance on the left side of the street. Contact Mr. Don Pullins (614/252-5233) and he will take you to this industry that is lcoated in the back of this warehouse complex. See enclosed map for more details.

2. Thick weeds, 2 and 3 feet high, are along the north side of the lead going into Royster Clark, Inc., from the switch off Rockwell Lead at Milepost BP 132. Royster Clark Inc./James Road Team Track, 3355 East 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43219.

Directions: This industry can be reached by taking the East 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue exit from I-670 and heading east. The industry is on the right hand side of street. After turning into the industry drive, there is a dirt road on the left that will lead you to this area. See enclosed map for more details.

3. On the REW Lead, there are weeds 2 and 3 feet high along both sides of this lead from the switch off the Rockwell Lead back to the industries, at Milepost BP 132. REW Lead, off the Rockwell Lead/East Port Siding/Milepost BP 132/CN Subdivision/Louisville Division.

Directions: This track can be reached by taking the East 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue exit from I-670 and heading east. Turn into Royster Clark, Inc., 3355 East 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The industry is on the right hand side of street. After turning into the industry drive, there is a dirt road on the left that will lead you to this area. See enclosed map for more details.

4. At Canam Steel, there are weeds 2 to 3 feet high along the north side of the rail from the switch off the Weyerhaeuser Lead, East Port Siding, at Milepost BP 131. Canam Steel, 555 North Yearling Road, Columbus, Ohio 43213.

Directions: This track can be reached by taking the East 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue exit from I-670 and heading east. Turn into IXL Cabinets Factory Direct Showroom 4331 East 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. This company is on the right hand side of street. After turning into this company follow their drive around to the back of the building. There is a dirt road off the back of that will lead you to this area. See enclosed map for more details.

5. Along the north side of the rail from the switch on the Weyerhaeuser Lead going for about five (5) car lengths, the weeds are 3 feet high and on the Weyerhaeuser Lead, about seven (7) car lengths from the crossover from the East Port Siding switch, there are weeds on the north side of the rail. Also, about eight (8) car lengths outside the gate leading into Weyerhaeuser Lumber, there are weeds along the south side of the rail. Weyerhaeuser Lead, off the East Port Siding/Milepost BP 131/CN Subdivision/Louisville Division.

Direction: Take the East 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue exit from I-670 and heading east. Turn right on Yearling Road and after a short distance you will come to the road crossing. The first track is the Weyerhaeuser Lead. Walk east (left) down he track and the second switch that you come to is the crossover switch (the first switch leads to a closed industry). This will take you to the first two locations.

You can also reach the third location from here - it's farther down at the end of the track. See enclosed map for more details.

By its failure to establish or maintain an adequate vegetation control program early in the season, it is now endangering the railroad employees required to use this area in the performance of their required duties.

It is requested that an investigation be conducted, under Section 4907.08, to determine if this railroad at the above location is in violation of your Commission's "Weed Order." If excessive growth is found, then an appropriate and timely order should be issued to require the elimination of the growth and the establishment of a vegetation control program to prevent the recurrence of such unsafe conditions.
