The Attorney Examiner, pursuant to the authority granted by Rules 4901-1-11 and 4901-1-14, Ohio Administrative Code, finds:


- 1) On January 19, 1995, the Office of Consumers' Counsel filed a motion to intervene in this proceeding.
- 2) Rule 4901-1-11(C), Ohio Administrative Code, requires that a motion to intervene be accompanied by a memorandum in support, setting forth the person's interest in the proceeding.
- 3) As grounds for intervention, the memorandum in support of the motion cites Chapter 4911, Revised Code, which vests the office of Consumers' Counsel with the authority to represent the residential customers served by Dayton Power and Light Company.
- 4) Having set forth a real and substantial interest, the motion to intervene should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to intervene filed by the Office of Consumers' Counsel in this matter be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
