ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 18, 2013, Charles King filed a complaint against The East Ohio Gas Company dba Dominion East Ohio (Dominion), alleging that Dominion had charged him for gas use from November 2006 through July 2007 at a property where he was not residing. Mr. King added that the readings for the period of time at issue were estimated and that he had never received a final bill until July 2012.
- (2) Dominion answered on February 12, 2013, by stating that it charged Mr. King for gas use from November 2006 through June 20, 2007, when gas service was disconnected for nonpayment. Dominion added that the bill for Mr. King's delinquent balance was due July 18, 2007, and was mailed to him on July 2, 2007. Dominion contends that, during the time period at issue, Mr. King's meter was read every other month.
- (3) On May 28, 2013, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss. In the motion, the parties state that Dominion and Mr. King have settled the matter, and they request an order dismissing the complaint with prejudice.
- (4) The Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.






