CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Pursuant to Rule 4906-11-02 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) hereby submits the following information for the Construction Notice requirements:

4906-11-02

(A) The construction notice being filed with the Ohio Power Siting Board contains all the required information set forth by OAC Rule 4906-11-02.

(B) General Information

(1) Project Name

The name of this project is "Sugarcreek - Centerville 138 kV Pole Relocation".

(2) <u>Description of the Project, Map Depicting Facility's Location, Reason</u> <u>Project Meets Construction Notice Requirements</u>

The Montgomery County Engineer has plans to widen and reconstruct a portion of Spring Valley Pike and Clyo Road in Washington Township, Ohio. Approximately 1,950 feet of Dayton Power and Light's Sugarcreek to Centerville 138kV transmission line is located within the road reconstruction project limits and the Montgomery County Engineer has requested that DP&L permanently relocate the 1,950 feet of 138 kV transmission line in order to accommodate the reconstruction project. Please see Exhibit 1 for a location map of the proposed project.

This project meets the requirements of a Construction Notice as it is a "relocation of an electric power transmission line and associated facilities where the project is required by publicly funded entities and is located on or adjacent to right-of-way or land owned by the public entity requiring the project" (OAC 4906-1-01, Appendix A).

(3) <u>Need for Project</u>

Montgomery County plans to widen and reconstruct a portion of Spring Valley Pike and Clyo Road. Approximately 1,950 feet of DP&L's 138 kV Sugarcreek to Centerville transmission line is located within the project limits. The existing alignment of the 138kV transmission line conflicts with the proposed design of the road reconstruction. Therefore, Montgomery County has requested that DP&L relocate the 138kV circuit to accommodate the road reconstruction.

(4) <u>Schedule</u>

Construction is planned to start October 1, 2013 and last for approximately three (3) weeks.

(5) <u>Capital Cost</u>

The capital cost for the project is estimated at \$202,000.

(6) <u>Operating Characteristics, Number and Type of Structures and Right-of-</u> <u>Way Requirements</u>

The proposed project will not affect the operating characteristics of the existing 138kV Sugarcreek to Centerville transmission line. The transmission line relocation will consist of removing seven (7) existing transmission poles and relocating six (6) of the poles with one (1) pole being replaced but remaining in its existing location. The existing transmission poles are typically 75'-CL1 to 85'-CL1 wood poles; the relocated poles to be installed are typically 80'-H3 to 95'-H3 wood poles. The existing poles contain 12 kV distribution underbuild and four (4) communication cables in addition to 138 kV transmission. The existing 1351.5 kcmil 61 strand AAC conductors as well as the 80 kcmil 8/1 ACSR static will be reused for the relocation project.

Additional right-of-way (ROW) easement will be required in order to accommodate the pole relocation. Additional ROW easement will be needed from seven (7) property owners, with additional needed widths varying from 5 feet to 18 feet. Montgomery County will be obtaining the additional ROW easements needed for the pole relocation and transferring ownership of the transmission ROW easements to DP&L. Some additional vegetation clearing will be required along Spring Valley Pike to accommodate the relocated transmission line. The additional vegetation clearing will be completed before the relocation work starts. Access to the existing and proposed pole locations will be from existing public road ROW. Please see Exhibit 2a-h for existing and proposed pole locations and additional ROW easement delineation.

(7) Map Depicting Facility's Centerline

To view the project site: from Columbus take I-70 West and drive approximately 55 miles to the I-675 South exit (#44). Drive approximately 19 miles on I-675 South and take the Wilmington Pike exit (#7). Turn left onto Wilmington Pike and drive approximately 0.5 miles. From Wilmington Pike turn right onto Clyo Road and drive approximately 4 miles to the intersection of Clyo Road and Spring Valley Pike. The project impacts the first three (3) transmission poles west of the intersection and the first four (4) transmission poles east of the intersection.

Please see Exhibit 1 showing the circuit centerline and Exhibits 2a-2h for the circuit relocation details.
