ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On April 18, 2013, James E. Moreland (complainant) filed a complaint against Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke or respondent) concerning the billing of his rental property.
- (2) Duke filed an answer to the complaint on April 30, 2013.
- (3) By entry issued May 30, 2013, the attorney examiner scheduled a settlement conference to take place on June 20, 2013.
- (4) On May 31, 2013, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint, without prejudice. The parties explained, in that joint motion, that they have reached a mutually satisfactory settlement.
- (5) Being advised that the parties have reached a settlement, the Commission finds that the joint request to dismiss the complaint, without prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.


It is, therefore,


