ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On July 5, 2013, Pete Spooner and Cindy J. Bias (Complainants) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (OE) and FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. (FES). In the complaint, Complainants allege that OE improperly switched their account to FES and that OE committed other billing errors.
- (2) On July 19, 2013, OE and FES jointly filed a motion for extension of time to file responsive pleadings and a request for expedited ruling. In the motion, OE and FES request an extension to August 5, 2013, to file answers in this proceeding.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that the motion jointly filed by OE and FES is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, OE and FES should file answers in this proceeding by August 5, 2013.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion for extension of time to file responsive pleadings be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
