- (1) On May 22, 2013, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling a August 14, 2013, evidentiary hearing in this case.
- (2) On August 8, 2013, counsel for Norfolk Southern Railway Company (NS) filed a request to continue the evidentiary hearing to October 30, 2013. NS explains that it has reinitiated discussions with Brown Township in an attempt to reach an agreement regarding the requested closure of the Stores Road/Township Road 159 grade crossing.
