The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 24, 2013, Michael and Janice Turnbull (the Turnbulls) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison), alleging that on October 8, 2012, their new furnace was damaged because Ohio Edison had not properly maintained the electric wires leading to their home.
- (2) Ohio Edison filed its answer on February 12, 2013. Ohio Edison admitted that it made a service call to the Turnbulls' address to repair wires and restore service to their property. Ohio Edison denied any remaining allegations made by the Turnbulls.
- (3) By entry issued February 19, 2013, the attorney examiner scheduled a March 21, 2013, settlement conference. The parties participated in the conference and continued settlement discussions afterwards.
- (4) On August 9, 2013, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss, indicating that matters have been settled, and requesting dismissal of the complaint with prejudice.
- (5) The Commission finds the motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, be granted. It is, further,
