<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- The above-referenced complaint was filed on June 5, 2013. In the complaint, Walter Reinhaus alleged that Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke Energy) unfairly and unjustly billed him for electric service.
- (2) On July 2, 2013, Duke Energy filed an answer denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) On August 13, 2013, Mr. Reinhaus and Duke Energy filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. In the motion, the parties stated that they have resolved the issues raised in the complaint and reached a settlement that is to the satisfaction of both parties. The parties, therefore, requested that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (4) In view of the resolution of the complaint, the parties' joint motion should be granted and this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the joint motion to dismiss is granted and this case is dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,
