## The Commission finds:

(1) On May 22, 2013, Anne L. Lauderdale (complainant) filed a complaint against two respondents, The Dayton Power & Light Company (DP&L) and Verde Energy USA Ohio, LLC (Verde Energy), alleging slamming and billing issues.

**ENTRY** 

- (2) DP&L filed its answer on June 10, 2013. Verde Energy filed its answer on June 11, 2013.
- (3) On July 18, 2013, Verde Energy filed a motion to dismiss in this case against both respondents, on grounds that the complaint has been settled among the parties. In its pleading, Verde Energy indicates that the complaint may be dismissed as a settled case under Rule 4901-9-01(F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (4) Rule 4901-9-01(F), O.A.C., provides that, if the public utility complained against files an answer or motion which asserts that the complaint has been satisfied and no response is filed within 20 days, the Commission may presume that satisfaction has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response to Verde Energy's motion to dismiss has been filed. Accordingly, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this case be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
