ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 3, 2013, Robert P. Madison International, Inc. (RPMI or complainant) filed a complaint against The Ohio Bell Telephone Company dba AT&T Ohio (AT&T Ohio) alleging, among other things, that AT&T Ohio unlawfully charged RPMI for telephone service at a temporary field office for a time period extending beyond that field office's closure.
- (2) AT&T Ohio filed its answer on May 28, 2013. An entry issued July 3, 2013, granted AT&T Ohio leave to amend its answer, which it did through a filing dated June 14, 2013.
- (3) On September 4, 2013, RPMI filed a motion to dismiss. In the motion, RPMI states that the parties have resolved the dispute that is the subject of this complaint case. Therefore, the complainant requests that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice and the record closed.
- (4) Because this matter has been resolved, the complaint should be dismissed and closed of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 13-1135-TP-CSS be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
