The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) By entry dated August 6, 2013, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for a settlement conference in the offices of the Commission on September 10, 2013.
- (2) The settlement conference was convened as scheduled on September 10, 2013. At the conference, the parties appeared to reach agreement on the issues in the complaint.
- (3) On October 15, 2013, Lyssa Holder contacted Commission staff and indicated that the terms of the written settlement agreement that she had received from Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. were not what she had agreed to at the settlement conference. Further, her electricity had been disconnected.
- (4) In view of Ms. Holder's assertions regarding this matter, the attorney examiner believes that a second settlement conference should be scheduled to take place telephonically on October 18, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. At that time, in order to participate in the conference, the parties in the case should call the following toll-free, dial-in number, (866) 209-2820, and enter the conference code, 1487311467.
