### What is Governmental Aggregation and how can I benefit?

Under governmental aggregation, an official brings the community together for approved group purchasing power. The community benefits by receiving lower prices and reduced rates from a retail natural gas supplier certified by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

### How is the County of Summit able to choose a certified natural gas supplier on the community's behalf and who is eligible?

Summit residents voted to give the County of Summit the ability to negotiate on behalf of the community for a contract for a natural gas supplier. At current participation in the program will receive no cost for the new program rates, terms and conditions and continue to be eligible for the program. All businesses must be received an opt-out notice from Constellation and must meet the following requirements:

1. You must not have already chosen a natural gas supplier on your own.
2. You must not be a PEP (percentage of revenue payment program) customer.
3. You must not be in arrears on your bill payment.
4. Your service address must be located within the County of Summit limits.
5. Your utility company must be Dominion East Ohio (DEO).
6. You must not be a residential customer (natural gas commercial accounts using over 500 Mcf/year).

### What does "opt-out" mean?

"Opt-out" means that you can decide not to participate in the County of Summit natural gas governmental aggregation program. You can opt-out by returning the opt-out form received in your mail or through the e-mail center using the phone number provided. If you opt-out, you will be billed as a natural gas customer with Constellation Ohio. You will also not receive the County of Summit competitive natural gas price.

### What happens if I do not send in the opt-out form?

If you do not submit the opt-out form by the deadline, you will be included in the County of Summit Governmental Aggregation program and receive competitive priced natural gas from Constellation.

### I am currently under the budget billing option as provided by DEO. Can I retain this service?

There will be no changes in your bill as they relate to budget billing and the method of billing used by DEO to calculate the same.

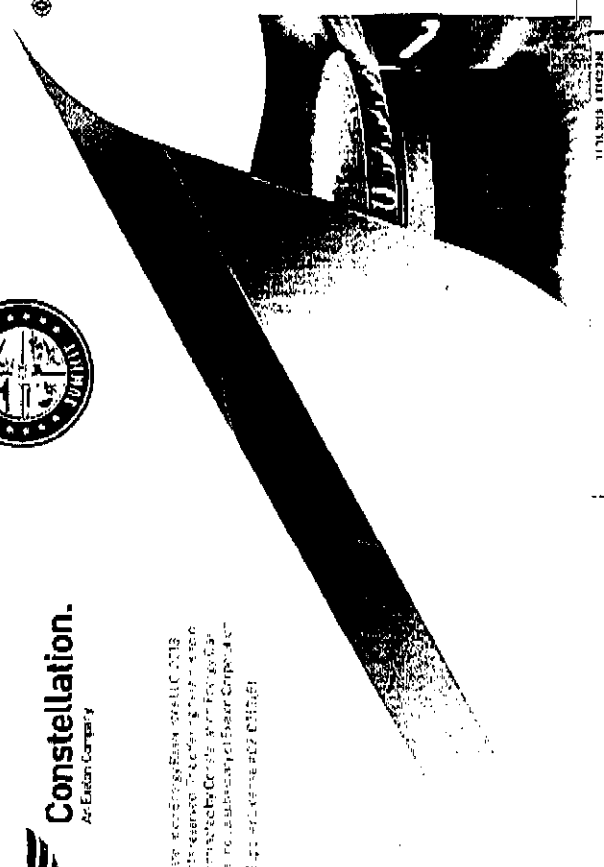


### Who is Constellation?

### What information do I need to opt-out?

Customers will need the 4-digit opt-out code provided in their gas opt-out letter. If this is not available, the customer care team can pull up your information based on the service address.

### Are there fees associated with the program?

Enrollment in the program is free and you need not take any action. You only need to see a bill to participate. Once enrolled in the program, you can cancel your agreement at any time and switch back to DFO without any fee.

### Will I be allowed to join the program after the initial enrollment period?

The County of Summit has secured the same natural gas supply rate terms and conditions for eligible customers who wish to join its government aggregation programs after the initial enrollment period. This would include customers who move into the County of Summit, who were with another supplier and would like to join the aggregation program, customers who wish to switch out and want to join after the initial enrollment period, or a later date. These customers will have an enrollment agreement with Constellation for natural gas supply but will retain the same natural gas supply rate terms and conditions of the aggregation programs.

### What is the rescission period?

The rescission period with DFO is seven days for broker-certified customers after enrollment with the new natural gas supplier.

### When will my Constellation natural gas supply begin and how do I know when my meter read occurs?

Supply will start on your first app change meter reading, which we estimate to be infrequently. Refer to your meter to get the exact meter read date.

### What if I am with another supplier and want to join the County of Summit's program?

Based on the records provided by the utility, we assumed your agreement with another supplier. If this is not the case, we would have sent you this notice. However, you recently signed up with a new supplier or you believe you are on a new contract. Carefully review the terms and conditions of that agreement before proceeding as your ability to terminate early with that supplier may be restricted.

### How can Constellation offer a lower price than DFO's current price?

During select market opportunities, Constellation buys natural gas at a lower price than DFO and then passes on these savings to its customers.

### How did the County of Summit develop this program?

The County of Summit established a program in accordance with Section 4929.26 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) providing the county with the right to aggregate the provision of Supplier Services for certain residential and small commercial customers that do not opt out of the program (the "Aggregation Program").

### Where can I learn more about natural gas deregulation and assistance programs?

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has approved a number of additional assistance programs to help customers with their energy bills. Eligibility and enrollment information about the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP), Winter Crisis Program (WCP), and others can be found on the PUCO's website at [www.puco.ch.oh.gov](http://www.puco.ch.oh.gov).

### What happens at the end of my Constellation natural gas contract term?

The County of Summit will notify the term and price of the bill for residents. You will be notified of the outcome by the county or your supplier for the new term.
