10 motion for a continuance at this time. We are going  
11 to give the parties time to continue to work towards  
12 a settlement in this proceeding and to get that  
13 reduced to writing and filed before the Commission  
14 for its consideration, and we are going to continue  
15 the hearing until November 14th at 10 a.m. The  
16 hearing room will be announced to everyone at a later  
17 point in time.

22 nothing, we are adjourned. Thank you, everyone.
