Re: Letter of Notification of Compliance for Northwest Ohio Wind Energy, LLC, Case No. 13-0197-EL-BGN

Dear Ms. McCauly:

Joint Exhibit 2 to the October 28, 2013 Joint Stipulation and Recommendation by Northwest Ohio Wind Energy, LLC ("Northwest"), the Ohio Power Siting Board Staff ("OPSB Staff") and the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation identified an agreed upon set of conditions and commitments pertaining to select access roads to be constructed after a first preconstruction conference.

Within this set of conditions and commitments, "Supplement to Amended Application Commitment #8," requires that:

General construction activities will be limited to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., or until dusk when sunset occurs after 7:00 p.m. Impact pile driving, hoe ram, and blasting operations, if required, shall be limited to the hours between 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Construction activities that do not involve noise increases above ambient levels at sensitive receptors are permitted outside of daylight hours when necessary. Applicant will notify property owners or affected tenants within the meaning of OAC Rule 4906-5-08(C)(3), of upcoming construction activities including potential for nighttime construction activities.

This letter is to inform the OPSB Staff that Northwest is in compliance with the above mentioned commitment. Attachment A to this letter is a letter from Northwest's project manager, Matthias Weigel, indicating that there will be no construction outside of the permitted hours and that the general contractor of the select access roads to be constructed after a first pre-construction conference, Miller Brothers Construction, will abide by the requirement.

Dear Grant,

I am writing to confirm that there will be no construction activities outside of the permitted hours of 7 AM to 7 PM, or until dusk when sunset occurs after 7 PM. There are no impact pile driving, hoe ram or blasting operations planned. This serves to address Commitment #8:

Supplement to Amended Application Commitment #8

General construction activities will be limited to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., or until dusk when sunset occurs after 7:00 p.m. Impact pile driving, hoe ram, and blasting operations, if required, shall be limited to the hours between 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Construction activities that do not involve noise increases above ambient levels at sensitive receptors are permitted outside of daylight hours when necessary. Applicant will notify property owners or affected tenants within the meaning of OAC Rule 4906-5-08(C)(3), of upcoming construction activities including potential for nighttime construction activities.

The general contractor, Miller Brothers Construction, has been made aware of this requirement as well and is committed to adhering to it as described above.
