The Ohio Power Siting Board finds:

- (1) On January 21, 2009, American Transmission Systems, Inc. (ATSI) and the Toledo Edison Company (Toledo Edison) filed a letter of notification for the Delta-Wauseon transmission line tap to ZincOx.
- (2) On March 2, 2009, Staff filed its investigation report and recommendation concerning the letter of notification. In the report, Staff recommended that the letter of notification be automatically approved on March 9, 2009.
- (3) Upon review of the record, the Board finds that considerable time has elapsed without notice that any action has been taken toward the initiation of this project. Consequently, the Board finds that, at this time, the previous approval of this project should be rescinded and this case should be closed. If ATSI and Toledo Edison wish to pursue this project, a new case, with an updated letter of notification, may be filed when work on the project is more imminent.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, in accordance with finding (3), our previous approval of this project is rescinded and this case is closed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
