MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Pursuant to Rule 4901-1-13, Ohio Administrative Code, the Commission may grant continuances and extensions of time for good cause shown. For the reasons set forth below, there is good cause for granting an extension of time until February 7, 2014, to file reply comments.

On December 18, 2013, the Commission issued an Entry setting forth a comment period for the review of Ohio Administrative Code Chapters 4901:1-36, 4901:1-37 and 4901:1-38 ("Chapters"). Initial comments are due on January 17, 2014 and reply comments are due on January 24, 2014, seven days from the deadline for initial comments. Given that initial comments are due on a Friday before 5:30 p.m., EDUs would only have five business days (excluding the weekend of January 18-19) to review any initial comments and draft reply comments, if necessary. For the EDUs, this compressed time may prove to be difficult given

that the rules encompass many different subject areas that will require different individuals' expertise. Allowing this additional time will also ensure that the appropriate employees at each utility have had the opportunity to provide meaningful review and comments to the Commission, if necessary. In addition, the EDUs cannot reasonably anticipate which interested parties may file comments on January 17, 2014, necessitating that they request an extension now, rather than wait until comments are filed tomorrow. While it is possible that reply comments may not be necessary, in an abundance of caution, the EDUs are requesting an extension of time until February 7, 2014 to review initial comments, if any, and provide reply comments if necessary.

This is the first request for an extension of time and the EDUs are not requesting this extension for purposes of delay. This extension also will not prejudice any party to this proceeding Accordingly, EDUs ask that all interested parties be permitted to file reply comments on or before February 7, 2014.

Rule 4901-1-12(C) of the Ohio Administrative Code allows a party to request that the Commission consider a motion on an expedited basis. Accordingly, EDUs respectfully request that the Commission grant this Motion on an expedited basis.
