COMMENTS OF FIRSTENERGY SOLUTIONS CORP.

Pursuant to the Commission's December 18, 2013 Order ("Order"), FirstEnergy Solutions Corp. ("FES") submits the following comment regarding Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") 4901:1-38.

During the May 7, 2013 Workshop, FES recommended that any customer taking advantage of special arrangements under the rule should have the opportunity to shop for generation. The Order stated that Staff believes generation options should be determined on a case-by-case basis.¹ FES proposes an additional rule in Chapter 4901:1-38 that captures the spirit and intent of these positions. The new section should read:

A customer taking advantage of an arrangement under this chapter shall not be precluded from selecting a certified retail electric service provider for generation service.

FES appreciates the opportunity to work with the Commission to further promote competition in Ohio and respectfully requests that the Commission adopt the above recommendation.
