The threshold for a NWP is 0.5 acres or less to cat. 1 and cat 2 wetlands. Since 0.498 is less than 0.5 acres, this project would meet the threshold for the NWP. Let me know if you have any additional questions.

Good afternoon Todd,

Per our telephone conversation earlier today, you indicated that the East Ohio Gas Company's (EOG's) Line 2888 project (L12273) would not require an Individual 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC). You are aware that EOG is proposing to impact 0.498 acres of wetland, which is less than the 0.5 acre threshold for instigating the Individual 401 WQC process. The Ohio Power Siting Board requested that EOG contact the Ohio EPA to verify that these activities would be authorized under the Nationwide Permit Program and that the Individual 401 WQC would not be a requirement.
