

THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

ENTRY

- (1) On January 16, 2014, Aaron D. Montz, Mayor of the City of Tiffin, Ohio, filed a letter requesting, pursuant to R.C. 4511.63, an exemption for school buses and motor vehicles carrying certain hazardous materials from stopping at three grade crossings within the City of Tiffin, Seneca County, Ohio, including Second Avenue (509-215K), Fourth Avenue (509-214D) and Fourth Avenue at Wall (509-217Y).
- (2) Commission Staff shall file a report of investigation on the matter by March 17, 2014.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that, in order for the public to have an opportunity to comment on the exemption request, a local public hearing should be scheduled. Accordingly, a public hearing on this matter should be held on April 1, 2014, at 1:30 p.m. at Tiffin City Hall, 51 E. Market Street, Tiffin, Ohio 44883.
- (4) The Secretary of the Commission should cause publication of the following legal notice in a newspaper of general circulation in Seneca County, Ohio, once, not less than seven days prior to the scheduled hearing:

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has scheduled a public hearing in Case No. 14-94-RR-RCP, on a request for an exemption for school buses and motor vehicles carrying certain hazardous materials from stopping at the following grade crossings located within the City of Tiffin, Seneca County, Ohio: Second Avenue (509-215K), Fourth Avenue (509-214D) and Fourth Avenue at Wall (509-217Y).

The purpose of the hearing will be to take public comment regarding the exemption request. The hearing will be held on April 1, 2014, at 1:30 p.m. at Tiffin City Hall, 51 E. Market Street, Tiffin, Ohio 44883. For additional information regarding this matter, contact the Commission's Hotline at 1-800-686-7826. The hearing impaired can reach the Commission by dialing 7-1-1 (Ohio Relay Service).

- (5) Pursuant to R.C. 4511.63, the Commission shall authorize a limited period for the filing of comments by any interested person regarding the exemption request. Therefore, any interested person may file comments on the exemption request by April 15, 2014.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Staff file a report of investigation as set forth in Finding (2). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a hearing be held in this case as set forth in Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That the Secretary of the Commission cause publication of the legal notice in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That comments on the exemption request be filed as set forth in Finding (5). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served by certified and regular mail on Northern Ohio & Western Railway, and by regular mail on the City of Tiffin and all other interested persons of record.
