NOTICE OF MINOR REVISION TO LETTER OF NOTIFICATION

On February 18, 2014, American Transmission Systems, Incorporated ("ATSI") and The Toledo Edison Company ("Toledo Edison"), FirstEnergy Companies, filed with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, Docketing Division, a Letter of Notification ("LON") for the Lemoyne-Midway 138 kV Transmission Line Tap to Home Depot Substation Project ("Project"). In this Project, Applicants proposed to extend the existing Lemoyne-Midway 138 kV Transmission Line as a tap approximately 0.4 miles to the new Home Depot Substation. As part of the Project, thirteen (13) new wood poles will be installed for the transmission line tap.

Since the February 18, 2014 filing of the Project LON, a landowner along the route of the tap has expressed concerns relating to the route of the project. More specifically, East Ohio Gas owns the parcel adjacent to the location of the Home Depot Substation and objected to the small section of the Project that diagonally crossed a corner of their parcel. In an effort to accommodate this landowner, this small section of the Project has been relocated such that it is located on the same parcel as the substation and extends north-northeasterly from the substation to the alignment that parallels the west side of Pemberville Road. The revised General Layout is shown in the attached revision to Exhibit 2, General Layout, from the original LON. Please note that the public notice published for this Letter of Notification application included a map with this revised General Layout identified on it.

Applicants believe that this revised route will address the landowners concerns and will not change in any way the minimal impacts from the overall Project.

Please accept this Notice of Minor Revision to the Letter of Notification, and the enclosed attachment, Exhibit 2, Rev. 1, as a supplement to the LON filed in this case. Should the Board or Administrative Law Judge require further information, please do not hesitate to request such information.


