# NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AFP Chin Transmission Company (AFP Obin Transcol has proposed to improve the transmission system near Leesville, Chia, by installing a new 138-kilovoit transmission line in Orange Township in Carroll County

The purpose of the project is to provide electhe service to Unca East Ohio Midstream LLC (Momentum) gas processing facility. The project will be constructed to 138-kV-standards for future load growth in the area however, the line initially will be energized for 69-kV service Construction is scheduled to begin in March 2014 with tree cleaning, followed by transmission line work in April 2014

The project is known as the Azalea 138-KV Extension East. As required by Ohio Revised Code Section 4906-11-01, AEP Obio Transco has filed a Lester of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board, under Case No. 14-0195-EL-BLN.

This project meets the requirements for a Letter of Notification because it is within the types of projects defined by Items (18f) of Attachment A of the interior process defined in the O#SB's September 4, 2012 Finding and Order in Docket 12-1981-GE-BRO. This states that a project qualifies for a Letter of Notification if the project is



The Letter of Notification for the Azales 138-IV Extension East is pending before the Ohio Power String Broad. This acclication has been assigned Case No. 14-0195-EL-BLN. This num ber should be included in all communications with respect to this proceeding.

Petitions to intervene in or comment on the Letter of Noblication will be accepted by the siting board up to 18 days following the publication date of this notice required by Rule 4906-5-(O)(I)(I), OAC Petitions should be addressed to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street, Columbis, Ohio, 43215-3793 and must cite Case No. 14-0195-EL-BLN

The Azalea 138-xV Extension East Project involves the construction of 20 new alternating braded cost steel cole structures. New conductor, insulators and hardware will be installed

The project will be an approximate \$2.4 million. investment by AEP in its transmission system



in the area. The project will allow AEP to continge to provide the level of service its customers expect
