

Re: Proposed Increase Rates for Aqua Ohio, Inc.

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is in response to the public notice printed in the <u>Pike County News Watchman</u> on Wednesday February 14, 2014 wherein the above monopolistic supplier of water to the unincorporated area of Lake White, Pike County, Ohio is "seeking increases and adjustments to, its rates and charges ...". formerly served by the Ohio American Water Company.

The notice declares that Aqua Ohio is seeking a 12.75 % increase for residential customers!

As I expressed in the survey form recently returned to your office that we retired pensioners received a 1.3 % COLA increase from the Social Security Administration for 2014. This request by Aqua Ohio is nearly 10 times that COLA. I also pointed out on the survey form that the potable quality of the water is questionable. We buy bottled water and lease the dispenser from The Water Shop in Portsmouth for our drinking water and for cooking purposes.

Further, since Aqua Ohio's takeover, the water quality has deteriorated to the point that even colored clothing and all whites must be done in Waverly to avoid brown staining. The discoloration of the water is conspicuous especially in our commodes. Even using a constant aid like a hydrogen peroxide-based toilet bowl cleaner from Lysol, we must scour the bowl at least 3 times per week and still there is a brown ring at water level. Showering/bathing? At your own peril.

Before you declare the content of this letter to be a crazy exaggeration of the current situation I invite you to visit the Lake White area <u>unannounced</u> and survey the users door to door or at least take a reputable sampling of the residents. Take water samples back to your lab and then decide if Aqua Ohio deserves a rate increase or a rate decrease.

Per the instructions posted in the Notice, this letter serves as an official notice that I, the undersigned, having standing in this matter, object to the proposed increase in rates as they are unjust and unreasonable pursuant to ORC 4909.19.

This action on my part will allow time for Lake White resident attorneys time to study and research the matter for future action(s). These actions would be filed in Pike County Common Pleas Court to resolve this matter.
