This letter is intended to provide your agency with information related to the purchase by Global Tel\*Link Corporation ("GTL") of 100% of the equity interests in Public Communications Services, Inc. ("PCS"), as of November 10, 2010. As of November 10, 2010, PCS became a wholly-owned subsidiary of GTL. GTL and PCS will continue to operate under their company names for a period of time, to permit the integration of PCS into GTL to take place in a smooth and orderly transition that has no negative impact on end users.

GTL continues to maintain personnel in the PCS Los Angeles, California office, who will conduct the investigations associated with end user complaints concerning service provided pursuant to PCS contracts.
