ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 14, 2014, Regan-Michael-OH-PV-6.75kW Residence (Applicant) filed an application in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F) for certification as an Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined in R.C. 4928.01.
- (2) Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F)(2) provides for automatic approval of an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, unless the Commission suspends the application within sixty days.
- (3) On March 13, 2014, Staff notified the attorney examiner that the January 14, 2014 filing by Applicant duplicates a prior filing by Applicant in Case No. 13-1440-EL-REN. Staff asked the attorney examiner suspend the current application so that Staff has time to contact Applicant and request withdrawal of the current application.
- (4) The attorney examiner finds that Staff's request is reasonable and that good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process with respect to Applicant's January 14, 2014 application.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for Applicant's January 14, 2014 application be suspended. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
