ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Ryan Montgomery, in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-12, alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On January 27, 2014, Ryan Montgomery requested an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- (3) The parties participated in a settlement conference on February 20, 2014.
- (4) On February 25, 2014, Staff filed a motion to dismiss the matter. In the motion, Staff explains that after a review of the facts in the case, as well as further investigation and discussion with the Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSP), Staff and OSP have concluded that further prosecution of the alleged violation of 49 CFR 383.51 is not warranted, and the violation should be deleted. Staff requests that the Commission dismiss the case and close the record.
- (5) The Commission finds that the motion to dismiss is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss be granted. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.




